MAKAR SANKRANTI



Makar Sankranti means 'transfer'. This day is considered as the transition day of sun into capricorn. To celebrate the deity Surya (Sun). To mark the first day of the sun's transit into makar rashi.

According to legends it is believed that sankranti - after whom the festival is named- was a deity. who killed a demon called sankarasur. In India, it is considered to be a date from when the sun began to move north as before makar sankranti the sun was shining on the southern hemisphere. Makar sankranti is one of the most unique festivals celebrated in India. Since, most Hindu festivals follow the position of the moon and are based on the lunar calendar. Thus, the dates of festivals change every year. But, makar sankranti is a festival which falls on the same day every year as it follows the solar calendar.



Makar Sankranti, a harvest festival falls on the equinox when day and night are believed to be equally long. It officially marks the beginning of spring or the onset of Indian summer and the days become longer and nights shorter.

Having *Til-Gul* i.e sesame seeds and jaggery in the form of sweets like *Laddoos* is a custom of this festival. Kite flying is an activity highly associated with Makar Sankranti. But, a sky full of kites becomes a death trap for birds Nylon Manja that causes injuries and deaths of birds, animals and even humans. To avoid this kind of loss.



We all pledged that no one will fly kites from this year in Mahalaxmi promises, and we celebrated sankranti without flying kites. We are requesting all of you to say no to the nylon and save their lives.
